General/Brief

We were selected by Winchester & Eastleigh NHS Trust for a three-year cabling contract to maintain the Trust's structured cabling network. This included the installation of additional copper and fibre cabling across the Trust's sites.

Winchester & Eastleigh Healthcare NHS Trust is an acute trust, which also provides technical infrastructure and support to Primary Care & Mental Health Trusts.

The Trust's headquarters are situated at the Royal Hampshire County Hospital in Winchester, one of 23 sites across Hampshire connected to the Trust's wide area network (WAN).

One of our biggest challenges was the Trust's buildings' range of architecture, covering everything from old Victorian architecture to temporary wooden units and modern buildings.

The Trust employs the latest fibre cabling for its infrastructure networks and currently has over 5,000 network outlets.
